Hi There!

We now have a bolt of (good quality) muslin, in stock as well as a few pieces of print "bed" sheets and some nice 100% (print) cotton fabrics, for your "backing". If you require any of these for your backings, give us a call.

If you happen to have a printed panel for place mats, for example, we suggest that you leave your panel "intact". In other words, don't pre-cut it. Leave your back "intact", as well. Gilbert can quilt it all in one piece and the costs would certainly be reduced. And once you get home, you just need to cut your "intact" panel into the required place mat size.

A 4 place mat panel, left "intact" and done in meandering, for example, would probably be minimum charge and would make a lovely Christmas gift, too!
