BOM: BLOCK OF THE MONTH
BUMP: BRING UP MY POST
DSM: DOMESTIC SEWING MACHINE
FOB: FEAR OF BINDING
FQ: FAT QUARTER
HST: HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE
LA: LONG ARMER
LAQ: LONG ARM QUILTER
OBW: ONE BLOCK WONDER
PP: PAPER PIECING
RR: ROUND ROBIN
SABLE: STASH ACCUMULATION BEYOND LIFE EXPECTANCY
SEX: STASH ENHANCING EXPERIENCE
SID: STITCH IN THE DITCH
SnW: STACK AND WHACK
TGIF: THANK GOD IT'S FINISHED
TIA: THANKS IN ADVANCE
TOT: TONE ON TONE
VIP: VERY IMPORTANT PROJECT
WHIMM: WORKS HIDDEN IN MY MIND
WISP: WORK IN SLOW PROGRESS
WWIT: WHAT WAS I THINKING
WOF: WIDTH OF FABRIC
WOMBAT: WASTE OF MONEY, BATTING, AND TIME
WOW: WHITE ON WHITE
